CLOSE SEASON NEWS

Close season news is quite limited this year, consisting of just one transfer, and a few international honours. No sacking of our Manager while he's away on holiday!

Frank Munro got four well-deserved caps for Scotland, carrying on as substitute against Ireland and England, and playing full games against Denmark and Russia. Hugh Curran got three more caps, making his total four, for Scotland, against Ireland, England (whom he scored against) and Denmark. Derek Dougan, as Captain of Ireland, added three more to his total of caps, against England, Scotland and Wales.

The one transfer was that of John Holsgrove to Sheffield Wednesday for £50,000. Holsgrove, for whom nothing went right last season, was made the target of the Molineux boo-boys after an unfortunate own-goal against Newcastle. So what with Frank Munro's sparkling displays preventing him from getting back in the team, and also the Molineux crowd turning against him, perhaps it is in Holsgrove's interests that he continues his career elsewhere.

Obviously, transfer rumours about Derek Dougan were frequent, with Preston, Q.P.R. and Blackpool supposedly interested in his services, but as usual, these were only rumours, and the "King of Molineux" remains, to continue his four-year career with Wolves.

Other rumours included Ipswich bidding for Hugh Curran, and also asking about Les Wilson and John Oldfield being unsettled. Another bit of news was that Jim McCalliog and Derek Parkin rejected the terms of their new contracts and are involved in a "pay revolt", but this should soon be settled.
