TRAVEL

The train charter facilities will again be used next season for all Saturday home games. The train from Euston will be the 11.10 arriving Wolverhampton 13.05 departing Wolverhampton 17.55 to arrive at Euston at 19.52. The fare will be £1.75 (females and under 14's £1.50). Coach trips will run to all midweek home games. The meeting place will be Elizabeth Bridge, Victoria at approximately 2.15, fare £1.75 - the same as the train trips. The coach leaves straight after the game, arriving back in London approx. 12.30.

Trips will run to most away games. Provisional fares should the game fall on a Saturday will be: Coventry £1.25, Leicester £1.50, Birmingham £1.60, Derby £1.75, Stoke £2.00, Sheffield £2.25, Manchester £2.60, Liverpool £2.75, Leeds and Burnley £2.80, Newcastle £3.50. For the matches at Southampton, Ipswich and Norwich, coach trips will run from Elizabeth Bridge, Victoria. Fares will be £1.00, £1.25 and £1.50 respectively.

Should any of these away games fall in midweek, then coach trips will run instead of going by train.

Exact times and fares of all games will, of course, appear in the newsletter. Bookings for all matches must be received not later than three days before the match.
